Work group Co-chair, Suzi Stolte, called the meeting to order at 3:05 p.m.

Approval of Minutes:

A motion was made to approve the January 2019 meeting minutes. Motion passed.

Video Debut Event:

The video event will be held on April 10th beginning at 6:15 p.m. in the Nighthorse Campbell building on the Anschutz campus. Sixty-five people have registered as of March 18th. The building has a capacity for 100 people. Light hors d’oeuvres will be served, followed by a 7 p.m. video unveiling. The Story Center is compiling the videos in a presentation that will include contextual explanations. Following the video presentation, there will be a panel discussion and an introduction to the Facilitators Guide that will accompany the videos when they are presented by other organizations. The guide is also intended to reinforce the Consortium messages of safe use, storage, and disposal and will contain a brief description of each video story and key messages. The guide will be available for download on the Consortium website. A follow-up survey will be sent to participants in order to obtain feedback regarding the stories and the guide.

Safe Rx has sponsored a portion of the food cost and will have a table featuring their prescription bottles. The bottles will be available at no cost.

Work group members also discussed whether or not it would be a good idea to promote the event in social media.

Development of Family Resources List:

Jen Place mentioned that there are many individuals who would like to have a resource list available to them. The resource list would include resources for families, relevant website listings, and support groups. Jen and Suzi are in the process of compiling resources and asked that other work group members send them any resource information they have available. The list will eventually be posted on the Consortium website. Help from community partners and work group members will be necessary in order to keep the listing up to date.

Jessica Eaddy mentioned a website maintained by the Regional Health Connectors. Dee Kessler is the contact. Jefferson County also has a resource listing, as does Pueblo County. Judy Solano will look into the existing resource listings available in Pueblo. She also mentioned they are planning CRAFT training on April 14 – 16th.

Jamie Feld will be conducting a teleconference on Friday, March 22nd. Participants will be discussing the current status of available resources.

2019 Goals:

The work group agreed on the following goals:

- Development of a resource listing
- Monitoring and marketing of story videos, to include a review of survey responses and possible collaboration with the Public Awareness Work Group.
